

## Cherry Orchard Primary School 2016/17

### Pupil Premium Grant 2016/17

The Pupil Premium Grant is allocated annually in the school budget for each child who is currently entitled to receive Free School Meals or who has been entitled to free school meals at any point over the last six years.

It is also granted to any Looked After Children and children of Service Families.

Cherry Orchard Primary School's Pupil Premium Grant for 2016/17 is £118,800  
The Pupil Premium Grant is intended to be used to support children's progress, attainment and aspirations.

Cherry Orchard has identified key areas of expenditure which will provide effective support for these children. These are monitored on a termly basis.
