A Scientist from Kings University hospital came and worked with Year 6, studying DNA. It was a great morning of practical science.

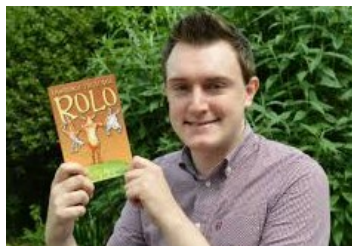
